



PBS Safety Net Pricing

With a valid Medicare card, the Australian Government has a PBS program that subsidises medicines to make them more affordable. As at 1st January 2021, consumers pay a PBS co-payment of upto \$41.30 for general patients, and \$6.60 for concession patients.
